

L25 Limited launches Alesis, an AI assistant for UK law firms that shows its sources

Every answer names where it came from, the assistant says when it does not know, and a firm's information is held in the UK and processed only in the UK and the EU

Chester, England, 19 August 2026. L25 Limited today launched Alesis, an AI assistant built for UK law firms. Alesis answers questions about a firm's matters from the matter's own papers and from official sources, counts key dates with the working shown, and names the source behind every point, so that a qualified person can check an answer before anyone relies on it. It is available today at alesis.ai.

An AI assistant writes fluently, answers instantly, and sounds exactly as confident when it is wrong. In most trades that is a curiosity; in a law firm it is a professional risk. Alesis is built backwards from the check. When it cannot find support for a point in the papers or in law, it says so and explains what is missing, instead of offering a confident guess.

Alesis is one conversation. What changes is what a fee earner asks it to help with, and which sources it answers from:

- **Matter review.** Ask what happened, who agreed what, and when. Alesis answers from the papers on that matter and points to the page each answer came from. If the papers do not say, it says that rather than filling the gap.
- **Research at the source.** Legislation section by section, official guidance, and Financial Ombudsman decisions read in full. Every point in the answer carries the source it came from, and every source opens in one click. For a bigger question, Alesis sets out the steps first and waits for the fee earner's go-ahead.
- **Key dates and figures.** A deadline or a calculation comes back as steps in plain English, each carrying the rule that allows it. Nothing is worked out in its head, and the firm's diary system still governs.
- **Documents, read properly.** Uploads are read page by page, so citations point at pages, and any page Alesis could not read is flagged rather than skipped quietly.
- **Drafts for sign-off.** Alesis prepares drafts and working documents. It does not file, serve or email anything: a qualified person reviews and signs off every draft, and people decide what leaves the firm.

"Impressive is easy. Checkable is the work," said Luke Roberts, director of L25 Limited. "Between a more impressive answer and a more checkable one, the checkable one wins, every time. Alesis is built for the person whose name goes on the letter. It shows where every point came from, and it tells them when it does not know."

Alesis needs no training and nothing to configure. If someone can write an email, they can use it: it is a conversation, not a search language. The one habit worth teaching takes a few minutes, and it is to open the source before relying on the answer. Where coverage of official sources is thinner, in Scotland and Northern Ireland, Alesis says so in the answer rather than papering over it.

A firm's information is held in the UK, processed only in the UK and the EU, kept apart from every other firm's, and never used to train anything for anyone else. Inside a firm, people see only the matters they are on, so work on one matter cannot surface in another. Alesis is compliant with UK GDPR, and is in the audit period for SOC 2 Type 2, ISO 27001 and ISO 42001; the live status of each is published on its Trust Centre at trust.alesis.ai.

Alesis is funded by credit, not a subscription. The first firm a person sets up starts with £25 of free credit and no card; each colleague who joins with a verified account adds £15, for up to 20 colleagues; and a firm tops up only when it chooses. There are no seats, no feature tiers and nothing that recurs. Prices exclude VAT and are published in full at alesis.ai/pricing.
